






























Components of Population Change, NC, 1981-2015



How many North Carolinians are not NC natives?













Net Migration by Age, 2000-2010











Net Migration by Age and Race/Ethnicity, 2000-2010






Race/Ethnicity of NC Children vs. Adults, 2015
