



Through a new grant opportunity, the NC 911 Board will provide to each approved seat in the Primary PSAP:

- 1 Portable Radio (including 2 batteries) per approved position to be based at the Primary PSAP and taken as needed to the Backup PSAP
- 2 Chargers (1 to be kept at Primary and 1 at the Backup)
- Programming per radio cost, ARS Encryption, and Code Plug
- Training for PSAP staff on use of the radios
- Maintenance for these Board-funded radios for the first 12 months

Applications are due by 5 p.m. on Friday, September 29, 2023

Requirements:

- * The PSAP will make direct purchase of the desired radios from the PSAP’s vendor of choice. Per application and agreement, the PSAP’s locality will be reimbursed for the purchase.
- * All portable radios purchased through this program must contain the VIPER Statewide required template as defined in the State Interoperability Executive Committee’s SOG.
- * The radios must be kept on the PSAP floor at all times for use by telecommunicators.
- * All radios must be accounted for during any PSAP readiness assessments or Board staff visits.
