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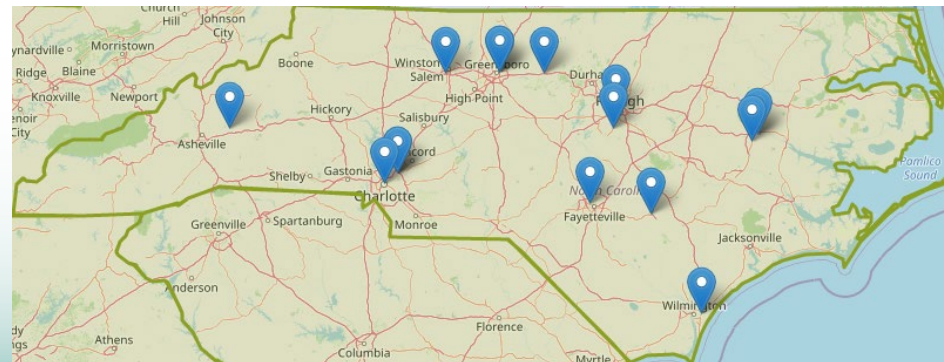

UNCW Cybersecurity Programs

IT Major with Cybersecurity Concentration: an interdisciplinary technical program emphasizing practical hands-on skills; some core courses focus on industry certification; students completing this path receive an NSA/DHS certificate

CS Major with Security Concentration: detail-oriented technical computer science program with a cybersecurity focus

Cybersecurity Minor: 18-credit hour interdisciplinary minor open to all UNCW majors

MBA with Cybersecurity Specialization: designed for managers interested in leading organizational cybersecurity programs

Cybersecurity Major: interdisciplinary cybersecurity program recently approved by the UNC Board of Governors; begins **fall 2022**; the first cybersecurity undergraduate major offered in the UNC system; some core courses focus on industry certification

 - Security engineer, information security analyst, network specialist, pen-tester, service delivery engineer, system support specialist

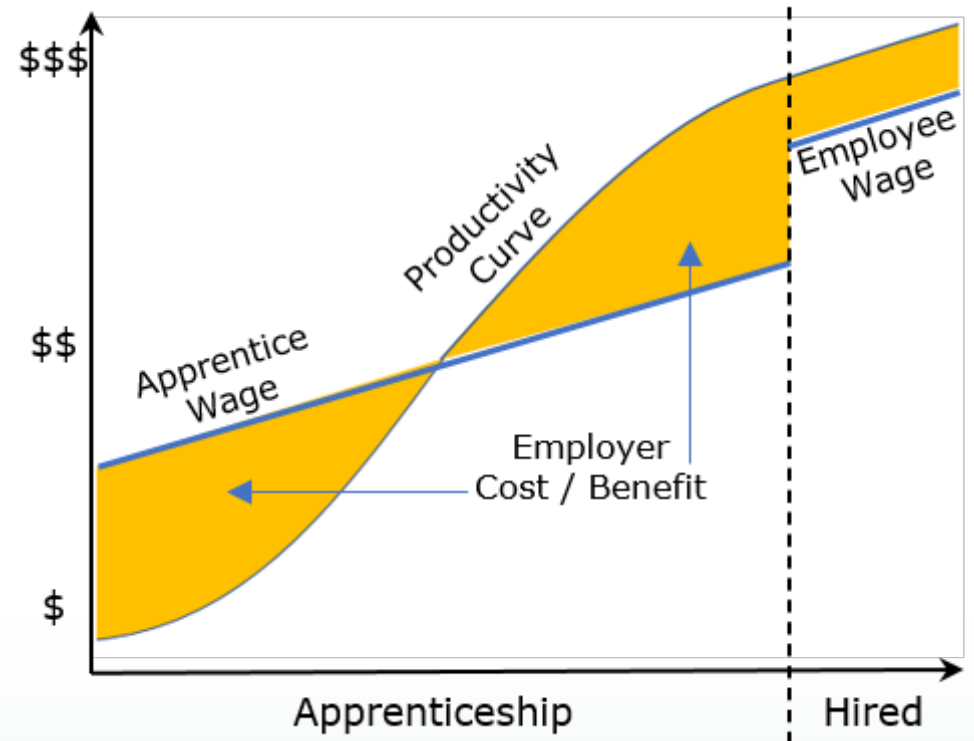


CCAP Grant

- Support of 4-year BS Cybersecurity program
- UNCW & CFCC partnership
- Emphasize a work-based learning environment
- Merge theory into practice
- Develop cyber personnel and workforce-ready graduates
- DoD - \$196K

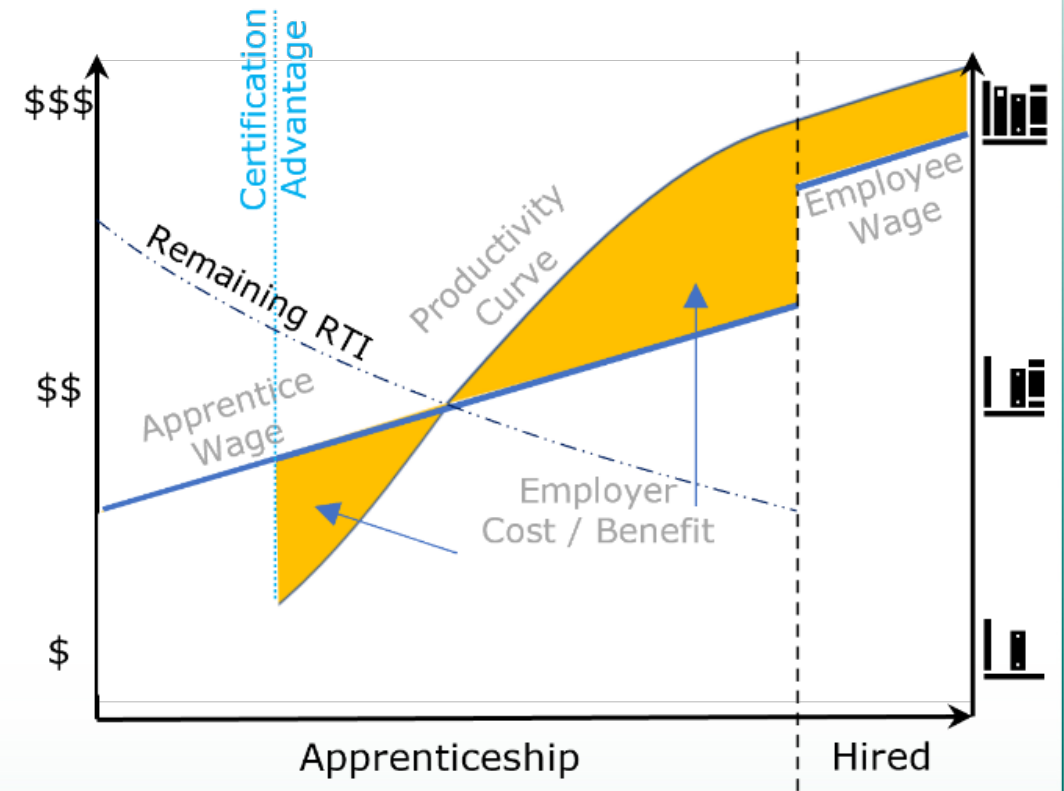
Cybersecurity Apprenticeship

- Registered Apprenticeship Programs (RAP)
 - Related Instructional Training (RIT)
 - Related Technical Instruction (RTI)
 - On the Job Training (OJT)
- Registered Pre-Apprenticeship Program



PCAP

- Preparation for Cybersecurity Apprenticeship Program (PCAP)
- Courses -> industry certificates
 - Network+, CCNA, Security+, CyberOps, CISA, CISSP
- Donations (advisory board, partners, etc.)
- Cost-share (75%/25%)



NC-PaCE Grant
