NCATP services

- AT Evaluations, Training and Technical Assistance, Device Demonstrations and Loans, Information and Resources.

Assistive Technology Device

"...any item, piece of equipment or product system, whether acquired commercially off the shelf, modified, or customized, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve functional capabilities of individuals with disabilities."

Categories of Assistive Technology

- Recreation, Sports, and Leisure
- Daily Living
- Environmental Adaptations
- Speech Communication

- Learning, Cognition, & Development
- Vehicle modification and Transportation

Levels of Assistive Technology

- Low Technology: No electronic components.
- Mid Technology: Electronic but does not use sophisticated computer components.
- High Technology: Complex, multifunction technology and usually computer based.
