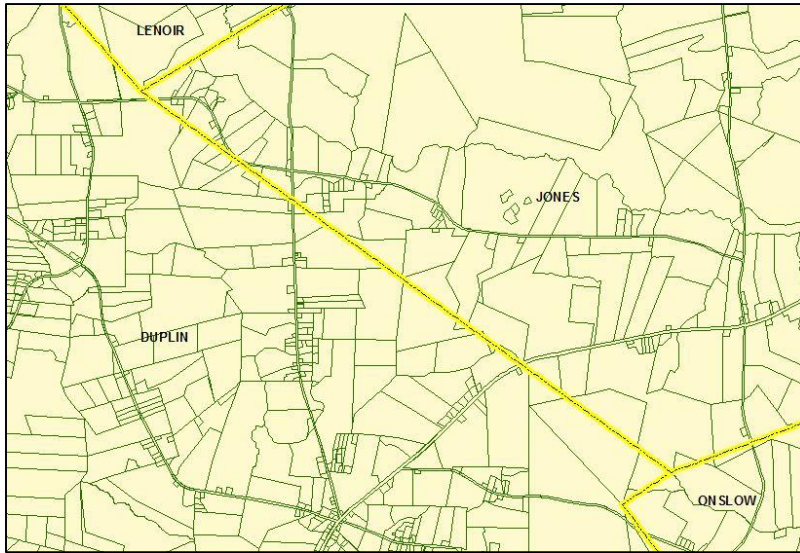


# NC Parcels

North Carolina operates an online tool that translates a parcel dataset from a county to a standard set of fields for the same geometry. All 100 counties participate.

## Parcels Transformer

- Matches county fields to standard fields
- Produces a transformed data layer
- Boundaries are unchanged
- Also creates a point dataset—same fields
- Creates a metadata record
- Saves translation models for next update

- Site address
- Mailing address
- Owner name
- Parcel assessed value
- Building value
- Land value
- Number of structures
- Structure present
- Multiple structures present
- Parcel identification number
- Deed book/page
- Deed date
- Acres (GIS and deeded)
- Subdivision
- Parcel use
- Sale date
- Transformed date
