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Background

- NCDIT asked GICC to review NC OneMap Disclaimer as it relates to:
 - publicly available geospatial data
 - possible resale and commercial use of the data
 - responsibilities in GS 132-10

Work We've Done

- Held meetings with Counsel to:
 - Review draft language
 - For clarity and comprehension combined Disclaimer and Privacy Policy

NC OneMap Disclaimer:

The NC Center for Geographic Information and Analysis (CGIA) is charged with the development and maintenance of NC OneMap and, in cooperation with other mapping organizations, is committed to offering its users accurate, useful, and current information. Although every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of information, errors and conditions originating from physical sources used to develop the resources may be reflected in the information supplied. The user must be aware of possible conditions and bear responsibility for the appropriate use of the information with respect to possible errors, original map scale, collection methodology, currency, and other conditions specific to certain data, web services or applications. While every effort has been made by data providers to ensure this information is accurate and reliable, there is no assumption of liability for any damages caused by inaccuracies in the data, web services or applications. There is no warranty, express or implied, nor does the fact of distribution constitute such a warranty.  - *To track who downloads what geospatial data, can login or account registration for access to NC OneMap be considered?*
 - *Follow-up with users who download data concerning resale?*

Legal Opinions

- Application of GS 132-10 to both local and state government entities
- Does “value-added” information appended to local government-sourced geospatial data by state entities then make the data “state-owned?”
- Feasibility of updating language in GS 132-10
 - Modernize data transfer media
 - Clarify pertinence to state government
