



A 1-minute daily task over a career... 8 days




Why Excel Online?








Why Power Automate?






- Easy to get into, well documented online






Excel Online

- Easy to get into, well documented online




How do I get to Power Automate?




Power Automate - Solo vs the team









Why Excel Online and Power Automate?

- Your Excel Online files already live in SharePoint and OneDrive.
- Power Automate can act on each row, sheet, file
- Excel is the *fuel* and Power Automate is your engine.







How does a Power Automate flow start?



"Someone updated my Excel spreadsheet, email the boss"



"Mobile app button pushed, or a menu item in a SharePoint list/library. Take some action on my Excel file"




"Add a row to my Excel sheet every Thursday at 10AM"


