<u>Telehealth in the Region:</u> The delivery of health care via phone or video consultation has become more and more popular. With the advance of broadband and communication services health care providers are finding it an effective and efficient way to care for their patients. As doctor-deserts emerge in rural and economically distressed areas of our state, telehealth has emerged as a solution for patients seeking care. The Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Rural Health has created a telemedicine team and a plan to implement telehealth services across the state.

#### **GREAT Grant Award Recognition (4:20 p.m.)**

The Growing Rural Economies with Access to Technology (GREAT) broadband grant program awarded 20 grants to improve broadband services in 18 Tier 1 counties. In Western North Carolina the following counties will benefit from projects supported by the grant program: McDowell and Macon (Morris Broadband) and Swain (Skywave) and Jackson (SkyFi).
