

Broadband and Digital Equity implementation progress

GREAT \rightarrow Received 305 GREAT grant applications to serve 94 counties

- Applications proposed to serve more than 487,000 businesses and homes
- Protest and public posting close Sunday, June 19; protest review and scoring; awards in July
- Broadband mapping and data lead hired

Completing Access to Broadband \rightarrow Draft program guidance posted for review in mid-June

- Program to officially launch in 2022 Q3; Program manager hired
- Developing convenience contract, prioritization based on county readiness
- Unfunded GREAT applications


